The CCR offers families a massive 50% reduction in their child care fees, irrespective of your income level.

-50% IS THE MINIMUM REDUCTION YOU MAY RECEIVE WITH YOUR FEES

Families with a combined income less than \$152,000 per year will also qualify for CCB as well as CCR, meaning even greater savings. Care can be as little as \$11.71 a day!

FAQ AND OTHER INFORMATION

CAN I INVITE MY CHILD'S FRIEND FROM ANOTHER SCHOOL?

Yes! anyone from prep-year 7 can attend World 4 Kids vacation care, even if they do not attend the school where the program is held.

CAN I ADD EXTRA DAYS TO MY BOOKING AFTER THE DEBIT DATE?

You can add extra days to your booking at any time, subject to availability of spaces. (see terms and conditions for full details)

WHAT IF MY CHILD IS LATE FOR THE BUS?

Due to event times, the bus cannot wait for late arrivals, so it is important to know the departure times and make sure you arrive 15 minutes early each day for excursions.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

ENROLMENT/BOOKINGS: 1. Prior bookings are required and need to be paid in full at least one week before the commencement of the holiday program. Families will lose their bookings if full payments haven't been received. // 2. Payment and Bookings must be made one week prior to the start of the holiday. // 3. Places are limited and taken on a 'first come, first served' basis, so get in early. // 4. An Enrolment Form must be fully completed and signed for each family. // 5. Bookings can be made to the Before and After School Programs between 6:45am and 8:45am or 3:00pm and 6:30pm, Monday to Friday. // 6. Any additional bookings during Vacation Care must be paid in full before the extra day your child(ren) is attending. Once the program has commenced, any extra bookings must be paid via credit card to our head office upon booking.

LATE FEE'S: Late fees apply to parents/guardians arriving after 6:00pm. A fee of \$50 per 15 minute or part thereof will be charged per family.

CANCELLATIONS/NO REFUNDS: Once made, bookings are permanent and cannot be cancelled during the program. Please make any alterations before payment is due (at least one week prior to the program commencing). If your child does not attend any of the days they have been booked in for, absent fees do apply. Refunds cannot be given if your child(ren) is absent during the vacation care period.

SICKNESS AND MEDICATION: The program cannot accept a sick child. If your child requires medication whilst attending the program, parents are required to label medication with the child's name, time and dosage required in the original packaging and must complete a medication consent form. Due to staffing and program costs, medical certificates cannot be accepted during the Vacation Care period for sick children.

EXCURSIONS/INCURSIONS AND ACTIVITIES: Parents/Guardians are advised to read the program details every day their child(ren) is attending. All excursions leave at 8.30am unless otherwise advertised and return times will be advertised at your centre. Please ensure your child(ren) is wearing appropriate clothing and footwear for the day's activities and any additional clothing is provided, for example bathers and jacket. (The program activities are accurate at time of printing.) Please note: World 4 Kids enforces a 'no hat-no play' policy during the September and January holiday programs. Every day your child(ren) must bring their lunch, snack and drinks. Money is not required unless specified on the flyer or instructed by World 4 Kids management. Only breakfast is provided between 7:00am-8:00am daily. World 4 Kids reserves the right to change the activities where necessary. Risk assessments of excursions have been completed and ratios are 1:15 or lower if required by assessment. Number of staff members and children in attendance are displayed at the program. World 4 Kids reserves the right to change an incurtion / excursion without notice should circumstances arise that prevent us from running the scheduled activity, for example, bad weather.

INDEMNITY: 1. World 4 Kids does not accept any liability for personal damage or loss sustained by any participant as a result of his/her participation in a program due to any cause unless negligence of World 4 Kids, its directors or employees is proven. // 2. I authorize the staff of World 4 Kids to obtain such medical assistance as they see fit and I will meet the expenses attached thereto. // 3. I understand World 4 Kids will retain and store enrolment information on a confidential database and that it can be removed if requested. // 4. I declare that the information provided is true and correct and that I will promptly inform the service in the event of any changes to this information. // 5. Transport for excursions will be by bus.
