Dear Parents,

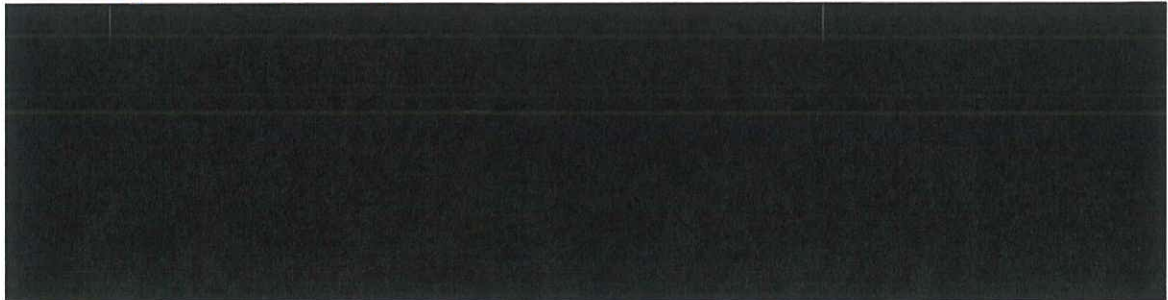

The stickers are converted into points that enables the school to purchase equipment and resources for school programs.

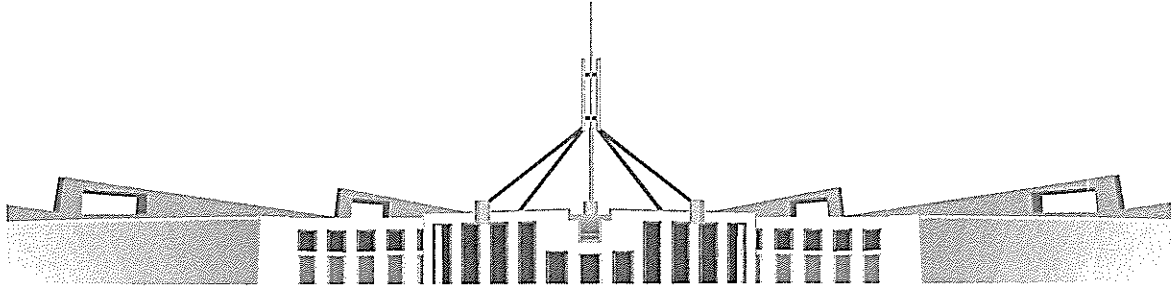
